There is no formal dining room and no set dining times – you can choose where and when you eat – by the pool, on the verandah, or at the beach.

With two private villas, two lofts, and a shared villa consisting of five suites (each with their own entrance), there is a range of accommodation options to suit individuals, couples, families and groups. Each room has its own en suite, and all rooms are air conditioned except Loft D and Loft M.

Whilst many people come here to relax, there is certainly no shortage of options to keep busy!

From November to April, a highlight of this area is the chance for an early morning boat trip to see playful dolphins and whales nearby! With an experienced crew guiding your trip, you will be amazed by the antics of the dolphins, sometimes in groups as large as one or two thousand! And if you are lucky you may see whales and sea turtles too. This amazing experience will be a highlight of your stay at Udekki.
